

Sun of the beach 2007 - Rules

Please note, there won't be a captains meeting. All teams are expected to be familiar with the rules below. If you have any questions ask the tournament organizers.

Pool play and play-offs

The teams are divided in 8 pools of 4 teams each. After this 1st round pool plays the two top teams of every 1st round pool progress to upper half and play for positions 1-16. They are again divided in 4 pools of 4 teams each. The two top teams of one 1st round pool progress to the same upper pool and keep the result of the game played between them. After this 2nd round there will be a play-off between the top eight teams (the two top teams of every upper pool) for positions 1-8 on Sunday, that means quarters, semis and the final. The two bottom teams of upper pools will have a play-off for 9-16. The remaining teams play for positions 17-32 in the same way.

Games are played to 13 (point cap) or 35 minutes + 1 goal (see rules about time cap). There is no half time in the pool play and every team has one time out. There is no time out in the time cap. The final is played to 15 (point cap 17) without a time cap.

The final is played to 15 (point cap 17) without a time limit and a half time at 8. Both teams have one time out per half time.

Point cap

If one team scores 13 points before the time is over and leads by two or more points the game is over. If the score is 13:12 game is played to 15 or until a team leads by two points.

Time cap

In one team leads by two or more points when time is up, the game is over. If not, then one point is added to the highest score. The first team to reach that score will win. When the time is over during a point, the point is still played, and then one point is added. If time is up after a point has been scored, the next point is also played, and then one point is added.

Brick

If the pull lands out of bounds, the receiver can choose to play from the brick point seven steps in front of the goal line.

Ties

If several teams end up on equal point, we then consider

1. Results in prior games between the teams in question
2. Goal difference between the teams in question
3. Total goal difference in the pool
4. Flip a disc
